GATOR SOCCER

Since its inception in 1985, the Allegheny women's soccer program has been built upon a tradition of excellence. The Gators have won eight North Coast Athletic Conference titles, have made four NCAA Division III National Tournament berths, and have amassed an overall cumulative record of 369-213-51, good for a .610 winning percentage. Allegheny women's soccer players have earned a total of 16 NSCAA/USC All-America honors and 62 All-Region selections, while six Gators have been crowned NCAC Player of the Year, and four NCAC Newcomer of the Year. In addition to their success on the field, the Gators have also excelled in the classroom, earning the NSCAA/USC Team Academic Award eight times since the 2008 season, while 14 players have been named NSCAA All-Region Scholars.
