Our initiative is committed to supporting creative scientists and the advancement of chemical knowledge. Successful proposals will address a heretofore unanswered question in basic chemistry and demonstrate technical proficiency in their subdiscipline. Submissions are invited from all subdisciplines of chemistry.

INITIATIVE GOALS: The goal of the Allegheny Senior Comprehensive Development Initiative is to support groundbreaking chemistry and biochemistry students as they transition to Scientists, in cutting-edge innovative research.

AWARD AMOUNT: Successful applicants will be awarded a passing grade in Chem/BChem 600/610, advancing eligibility for graduation.

- Gators majoring in Chemistry or Biochemistry who have successfully completed Chem 584.
- Only one proposal from an individual student is accepted per year (see guidelines).
