## The Department of Chemistry invites applications for the 2025 Ruth Ann Verell Scholarship at Oak Ridge National Laboratory

The Oak Ridge National Laboratories Internship Endowment was established by Dr. Ruth Ann Peterson Verell, Class of 1957. The fund supports an internship for a current Allegheny student at the Oak Ridge National Laboratory. The internship appointment is 10 weeks during the summer (May through August).

The award provides a \$4,500 stipend and a \$2,000 allowance to offset the costs of travel and accommodations. Interns should have a car at their disposal, as there is no housing within walking distance of the research facilities.
