## NUMBER OF STUDENTS ATTENDING SYMPOSIUM

YMCA Camp Kon-O-Kwee is requiring specific adult to student ratios depending on student age. Students 9-14 years: 1 adult for every 10 students

Students 15-18 years: 1 adult for every 12 students

YMCA is also requiring every adult (18 years+) attending to register ahead of time.

From past experience, we've found that a limit of students per teacher or adult chaperone allows us to provide a positive learning experience, as well as making it easier for teachers to keep track of students. We would hope that each school brings students that are **genuinely interested in attending** and who have earned the privilege to attend. We also expect all students in attendance to be well behaved, follow school policies, show respect for others in attendance, and participate fully in the day's events. Teachers are responsible for their students throughout the day and we expect that you will participate actively in symposium activities.

## NEED TRI-FOLD DISPLAY BOARDS?

Creek Connections has the cardboard, tri-fold research display boards ready for your students' tabletop display presentations. As prices of everything has increased, please only request the number you need and if you have a lot of students – have them work in groups.

At this point in the school year, you should have collected data on three to five occasions. Please remember that the expectation is eight sampling trips per year. If you collected data during the fall semester and have yet to submit it to Creek Connections, please do so immediately. Enter data by using the online data submission form (Water Data tab on the website), or scan/photograph and email your data sheet(s), or snail mail your completed data sheets to Wendy. Take a moment to review your data posted on-line. If you submitted data before the end of December and it is not yet showing up on-line, we did not receive your data. Please resend these data immediately. Also check on-line data for accuracy. Creek Connections interns double-check all of their work but mistakes still happen from time to time. Contact Wendy if you discover any errors.
