**Bring to the symposium:**

- LUNCHES – again this year, bring lunches for yourself and your students
- Students who have participated in sampling and research this school year – YMCA Camp Kon-O-Kwee is requiring specific adult-to-student ratios depending on student age.
- Students 9-14 years: 1 adult for every 10 students
- Students 15-18 years: 1 adult for every 12 students
- YMCA requires completion of an online waiver from every person attending but we still encourage you to bring:
  - Faculty colleagues at your school, or in your school district, who might like to participate in some capacity next year (e.g., biology, earth science, chemistry, geography, environmental science, English, art, etc.)
  - School administrators
  - Chaperones / parents

**Provided by Creek Connections for the symposium:**

- Substitute reimbursement to your school (Case-by-case basis)
- Busing money to symposium (Case-by-case basis)
- Tri-fold Display/Presentation boards (cardboard) – let us know how many you need NOW
- You can buy art supplies and other display supplies with your equipment stipend money – submit receipts by May 1<sup>st</sup>
- PRINTING: If your students have created some kind of handout, brochure, or visual aid for their display; we can help with printing if it cannot be reproduced at your school. This work must be submitted to Creek Connections at least 1 week before the event.

**Focus Group Activity Information:**

Presented by Allegheny staff and students and environmental organizations, these are hands-on, field or laboratory activities about various watershed topics. We plan to have over 20 again this year. They are held all over the Camp Kon-O-Kwee grounds and most will be outside (have students dress for the weather). Students from various schools are mixed for these activities (your school does not all go to the same activity unless there is a reason that your group needs to stay together – if so, let Wendy/Laura know). Each activity will be chaperoned by a teacher; you will be assigned to one. After registering, your students will be assigned to an assortment of focus groups. The actual tickets won't be given to you until the day of the symposium, but you will receive the focus group assignments ahead of time. *We must receive your registration by March 8<sup>th</sup> to plan the focus group activities.*
