Focus Group Activity Information:

Presented by Allegheny staff and students and environmental professionals, these are handson, field or laboratory activities about various watershed topics - 12:15-1:15pm. We plan to have over 20 this year again. They are held all over Allegheny's campus; inside and outside (have students dress for the weather). Students from various schools are mixed together for these activities (your school does not all go to the same activity unless there is a reason that your group needs to stay together – if so, let Wendy know). Each activity will be chaperoned by a teacher, you will be assigned an activity to attend. You will be assigned an assortment of focus group activities. You will receive the actual tickets on the day of the symposium, but you will receive your focus group assignments ahead of time.

We must receive your online form submission by <u>March 15th</u> to plan the focus group activities.

In future memos regarding the symposium, you will receive:

- An Oral Presentations schedule (Files needed for oral presentations are preferred as Google Slides (make public, but we can also accept files emailed ahead or on a USB flash drive (PC files only – no Mac files) or save as a Google Presentation and make public – send us link – no CDs or other disks)
- Information about focus group activities (including ticket allotment)
