Stephen has performed as a percussion soloist with the Allegheny College Wind Ensemble, Grove City College Concert Band, Slippery Rock University Concert Band and with various high school and elementary bands. Stephen taught instrumental and vocal music in the public schools for 14 years in grades K-12, and has been a public school administrator for 21 years. Presently he is the principal at Conneaut Valley Elementary School with the Conneaut School District. Stephen has been the Professor of Percussion at Allegheny College for six years, where he teaches Applied Percussion and the Percussion Ensemble.
