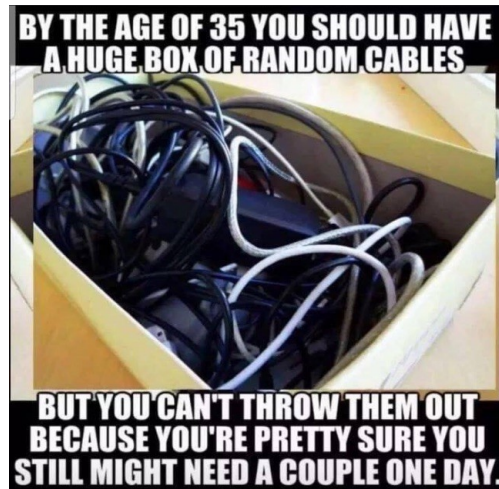
“I've discovered a love for flowers :)”
